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1. PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

1.1 BRIEF HISTORY OF THE DECCAN EDUCATION SOCIETY

The great visionaries namely **Bal Gangadhar Tilak**, the Father of Indian Unrest ; **Principal Gopal Ganesh Agarkar**, the Social Reformist; **Mahadeo Ballal Namjoshi** and **Vishnushastri Chiplunkar**, the great Marathi writer; together founded **Deccan Education Society** as a surest way of national regeneration on **24th October, 1884** at Pune (Maharashtra State).

1.2 BRIEF HISTORY OF WILLINGDON COLLEGE

In order to meet the growing demand of higher education in the Southern Maratha Country and North Kannada Region, the Deccan Education Society decided to start a College in the year 1919. His Excellency Lord Willingdon, then Governor of Bombay, was approached and his support was taken in order to seek the permission of the same from the British Government. In appreciation of Lord Willingdon's interest and timely

help, it was decided to name the college after him. The Rulers of Southern Maratha Princely States were approached for help and finance was sought generously. Honourable Members of the Society selected the neighbourhood of Sangli and Miraj as a suitable site for the College as it lay in the centre of South Bombay Province. The College was declared open on **22nd June, 1919** and was affiliated to the Bombay University in the beginning. After the establishment of Pune University, the college was affiliated to the Pune University.

Today it is one of the leading institutes of Maharashtra imparting Under-graduate and Post-graduate courses in Arts and Science faculties under the affiliation of Shivaji University, Kolhapur. The college is spread over vast campus equipped with **Rich Library, Modern Laboratories, Spacious Class Rooms, an Auditorium, Gymkhana Complex, Principal's Residence, Boys' and Girls' Hostels with Mess Halls, Teachers' Quarters, Residential Bungalows for Life-Members, Large Play Grounds, Guest House and Deccan Education Society's Sangli Regional Office.**

As planned by the IQAC various schemes were initiated in the academic year 2010-2011 with the financial assistance given by the UGC under XI plan. Students were extremely benefited by these activities.

The activities undertaken were as follows -

1. Colleges with relatively higher proportion of SC/ST/OBC

To promote the participation of different social groups, special grant was provided to the colleges with relatively higher proportion of socially backwards and financially weak students. A stipend of Rs.500/- per month was given to the students belonging to disadvantaged categories. A Committee headed by Principal formed to shortlist the students on the merit basis. Weightage was given to performance in the last years examination.

2. Establishment of UGC Network Resource Center

College has setup a Network Resource Center at Language Laboratory for information access, examination, administration activities for under Graduate and Post Graduate level as well as for Research Purpose of M. Phil and Ph.D. The Main aim to establish the Network Resource Centre is to provide network resources, internet facility and to create awareness of the computer networks and its use in students and the staff.

Six computers, web camera, network switches, net protector software were purchased out of grant received from the UGC and provided network connection with category 6 cable to the various departments in the college. Internet connectivity is provided to department and available to students and staffs during the working days from 7.30am to 6.00 pm. Nearly 80 staff members and about 1100 students from UG & PG classes were benefited from this scheme.

3. Equal Opportunity Center in Colleges

The college has started 'Equal Opportunity Centre' for educational, economic, social and qualitative progress and guidance of the students belonging to SC, ST, OBC, Handicapped and Minority category. The main objective of 'Equal Opportunity Centre' is to help and solve the problems of weak and socially backward class students.

The entrance exam was held on 31/07/2010 to give admission to 'Equal Opportunity Centre'. 31 students took admission in this Scheme. The students of SC, ST, OBC, NT category mainly participated in the programme.

The 'Equal Opportunity Centre' had organized a lecture of Prof. Subhash Dagade (HoD Department of Economics, Smt. Mathubai Garware Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Sangali) on 18/09/2010 on 'Reservation Policy for Equal Opportunity'.

The Centre had organized a Computer Training Programme from 20/10/2010 to 30/10/2010. Thirteen students participated in the programme. Mrs. Jayashri Kalale (Proprietor of a private computer training institute) and her staff Mr. Surendra Naik gave a computer training for the participants.

The centre had organized following One-Day Workshops for the students-

- (1) 'Personality Development' on 03/03/2011.
- (2) '**Opportunities in Mass Media**' on 25/01/2012.

4. Remedial Coaching for SC/ST/OBC (excluding creamy layer) and Minorities

The scheme focused on the under privileged students to stand-up on the strong academic footholds so that they can come up to the necessary level for pursuing higher studies efficiently and to reduce their failure and drop-out rate. Under the scheme students from SC/ST/OBC and Minority communities were given special Remedial Coaching. Main objective behind the Coaching was to improve academic skills, linguistic proficiency and acquaint the students with Computer skills .

7. Career and Counseling Cell

Career and Counselling Cell has been established to support the students in the development of soft skills and communication ability.
